



## Cheshire Land Trust - Brooke Preserve

Elizabeth Carpenter resided with her family on 45 acres of hilly forested property at the corner of Sperry Road and Cook Hill Road. The property was acquired over time by her father and had served as a summer retreat for her family beginning in the 1920's. She hoped to see it preserved as she had always known the land to be... wild and little changed by the imprint of man. Today 40 acres of the property are permanently protected.
